MEDICINES IN SCHOOL

On the advice of Doncaster School Nursing, schools must only accept and administer medicines prescribed by a medical practitioner where the required dose is to be taken 4 or more times a day.

On accepting medication, the child's parent/carer must also sign a form giving consent for the medication to be administered.

Please ensure that you do not send your child to school with any medications in their school bags (including cough sweets) as these could cause a hazard to the child or to another child if found and swallowed. Parents are welcome to come into school to administer medicines themselves.
