### UNIFORM

Our school uniform is an important expression of our pride in ourselves as a school and we expect all students to be in correct uniform.

<b>Shoes</b>	Low heeled and soft soled. No trainers or boots
<b>Tie</b>	The school tie must be worn
<b>Trousers</b>	Plain grey, no extremes of length or width, cotton or cord not permitted, straight leg, not stretch fabric
<b>Skirt/Tunic</b>	Plain, grey
<b>Shirt</b>	Plain white, no fashion/sports shirts, no monograms or emblems, not fitted
<b>Cardigan</b>	Red School cardigan
<b>Sweatshirt</b>	Red School sweatshirt
<b>Socks</b>	Dark coloured (trousers) White (dress/skirt)
<b>Tights</b>	Dark coloured
<b>Jewellery</b>	A wristwatch, a chain and simple cross or religious medal, rings should not be worn. One pair of small, plain ear studs
<b>Make-up</b>	No make-up should be worn, this includes nail varnish

### PE KITS

P.E. is a national requirement for children and all children need to have their P.E. kits in school on the days that they do P.E. P.E. kits can be kept in school for the whole half term.

P.E. kits consist of a white T shirt and navy shorts for indoor activities. For outdoor activities, the children need to wear a white T shirt, tracksuit bottoms and top, and a pair of trainers.
